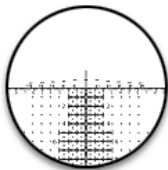

MORE INFORMATION WHEN YOU ENTER THE SHOOT. LUNCH WILL BE PROVIDED . NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED.

There will be 10 rounds per fire course.

The shooter may bring own spotter.

This is a versus match, the winner moves on the loser watches.(If we do not get enough shooters there will be a second shoot off from the losers bracket.)

TARGETS

The target size and range will be sent to the shooters via email or mailing services. The range and pictures of targets will also be place on internet site.

The directions will also be placed on internet and also sent by email or mail services.

The first round for shooters will have five targets

With the last target being a stop plate.

The second round will have six targets also ending with a stop plate.

The final stage will have seven targets also ending with a stop plate.

A hit on the target is enough to move on to next target . The round must hit target and not the target stand.

The targets will be shoot from closet to the furthest . Until the last target is hit then you may move to stop plate which will be at a closer range.

WEATHER

If storms or very strong winds are on the day of shoot the shoot will be moved to a different date .

Rules for shooter

- 1.The shooter may use any bolt gun other than a .50cal .
- 2.The rifle bolt must be open when entering and leaving the firing line.
- 3.Must wear hearing protection and eye protection.
- 4.Both shooters will fire after left and right shooter say they are ready and the command of fire is given.
- 5.The range masters will also be spotting if the shooter needs help confirming a hit.
- 6.If both shooters stop on the same target and can't advance, there will be a shoot off from last target hit working back down with two other stop plates for shooters.
- 7.If either shooter can not make it to the stop plates then the shooter that has the longest target hit will move on.

OBSERVERS

Observers will be behind firing line at all times. Must wear hearing protection !!!
